

Instructions for: Quick & Easy Clutch

Read all instructions before beginning project.

Use 1/2" seam allowances unless otherwise

Materials:

1. Sewing Machine & general sewing supplies
2. Iron & Ironing Board
3. Ruler
4. Pen
5. 1/4 yd. of Fabric 1
6. 1/4 yd. of Fabric 2
7. 1/4 yd. Heavy weight interfacing
8. 1 Magnetic or sew-on snap closure
9. 4 Yo-yos
10. 4 Beads or buttons

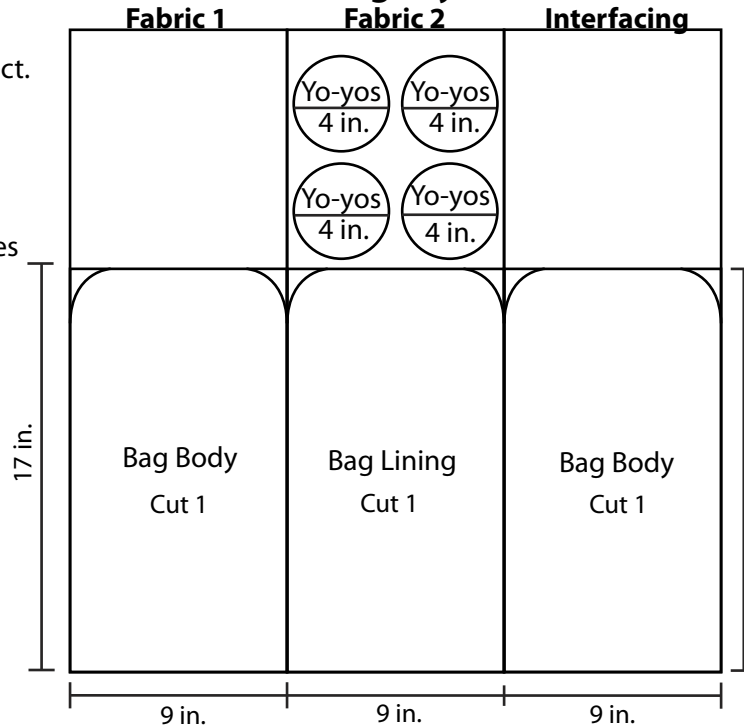
Assembly Instructions:



Right Side Wrong Side Interfacing

1. Apply fusible interfacing, following manufacturer's instructions, to the bag body.
2. If using a sew-on snap, skip to step three. If using a magnetic snap, then apply the male snap 1 1/2" from the top of the bag lining in the center. Apply the female snap to the bag body 2 3/4" up from the bottom in the center.
3. With right sides together, pin bag body to lining, stitch using a 1/2" seam allowance and leaving a 3" opening at bottom for tuning. Trim seam to 1/4", clipping curves and corners. Turn to right side and press.
4. Top stitch around all sides of bag using a 1/4" seam allowance, being sure to catch opening in seam.
5. Measure 5 1/2" from bottom of bag and mark with pins on both sides. Fold the bottom of bag at this mark and pin on both sides. Stitch sides down along the top stitch.
6. If using a sew-on snap sew the male snap to lining of bag in the center 1" from top edge. Sew the female snap 3" from bag bottom.
7. Fold the top of the bag so that the snap closes. Press bag.
8. Make yo-yos. Sew beads onto center of yo-yos. Sew yo-yos along the edge of the bag flap.
9. Enjoy!

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 1:

1. Cut 1 9" x 17" rectangle for your bag body, use the edge of a round plate to create round edges at top of bag.

Fabric 2:

1. Cut 1 9" x 17" rectangle for your bag body, use the edge of a round plate to create round edges at top of bag.
2. Cut 4 4" diameter circles for your yo-yos.

Interfacing:

1. Cut 1 9" x 17" rectangle for your bag body, use the edge of a round plate to create round edges at top of bag.
