SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1 1/4 yds Master Patch
- 2/3 yd Spot On Texture Green
- 2/3 yd Purple Elegance
- 2/3 yd Spot On Texture Yellow
- 1/3 yd Lilly Pad Delight
- 1/2 yd Tulip Bliss
- 2 3/4 yds Postcard Squares - Backing Fabric
- Twin size batting
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine

DIRECTIONS:

- Please read all directions before beginning and press after each step.
- All seam allowances are 1/4".
- WOF = Width of Fabric
- LOF = Length of Fabric

CUTTING (label pieces as you cut) cut strips in the order listed:

- From Master Patch cut:
- One strip 20" x WOF. From the strip cut one square 20" - Unit 1.
- One strip 4" x WOF. From the strip cut two rectangles 14 3/4" x 4" - Unit 2.
- One strip 4" x LOF. From the strip cut two rectangles 14 3/4" x 4" - Unit 3.
- From Spot On Texture Green cut:
- One strip 4" x WOF. From the strip cut four corner squares - Unit 4.
- Two strips 4 1/2" x WOF. From the strips cut eight squares (for 1/2 square triangles) - Unit 5.
- One strip 4 1/2" x WOF. From the strip cut four squares (for square in a square blocks) - Unit 6.
- From Purple Elegance cut:
- Two strips 1 1/2" x WOF. From the strips cut two pieces 20" x 1 1/2" - Unit 7.
- Two strips 1 1/2" WOF. From the strips cut two

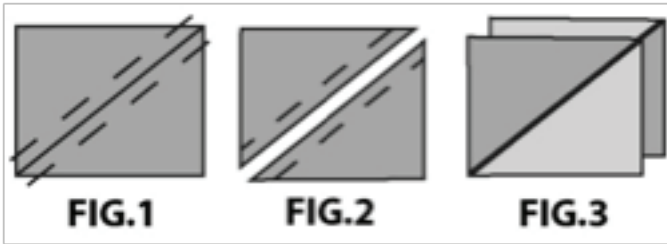


- pieces 22" x 1 1/2" - Unit 8.
- Cut two strips 4 1/2" x WOF. From the strips cut eight squares - Unit 9.
- Cut two strips 4" x WOF. From the strip cut eight rectangles 11 3/4" x 4" - Unit 10.
- From Spot On Texture Yellow cut:
- One strip 4 1/2" x WOF. From the strip cut eight squares - Unit 11.
- One strip 4 1/2" x WOF. From the strip cut four squares, cut the four square in half to make eight triangles (for square in a square blocks) - Unit 12.
- Five strips 2 1/4" x WOF = Binding - Unit 13.
- From Lilly Pad Delight cut:
- Two strips 4 1/2" x WOF. From the strips cut eight squares - Unit 14.
- From Tulip Bliss cut:
- One strip 7 1/2" x WOF. From the strip cut four squares - Unit 15.
- One strip 5 1/2" x WOF. From the strip cut four squares - Unit 16.



ASSEMBLY:

1. Make thirty-two half square triangle squares.
Place two 4 1/2" squares right sides together. Each pair makes two squares.
Draw a line from corner to corner on the top square of each pair.
On both sides of the line sew a seam 1/4 inch from the line.
Cut the squares apart on the drawn line. Press open. Trim the squares to 4".



Step 1

Pair the squares as follows:

- Four Purple Elegance and Four Spot On Dot Yellow – (sew one of each together to make four)



- Four Spot On Dot Yellow and Four Lilly Pad Delight – (sew one of each together to make four)



- Four Spot On Dot Green and Four Lilly Pad Delight – (sew one of each together to make four)



- Four Purple Elegance and Four Spot On Dot Green – (sew one of each together to make four)



2. Sew one Unit 7 Purple Elegance 20" x 1 1/2" piece to the top and bottom of the Unit 1 square. (Step 2)
3. Sew one Unit 8 Purple Elegance 22" x 1 1/2" piece to the two remaining sides of the Unit 1 square. (Step 3)

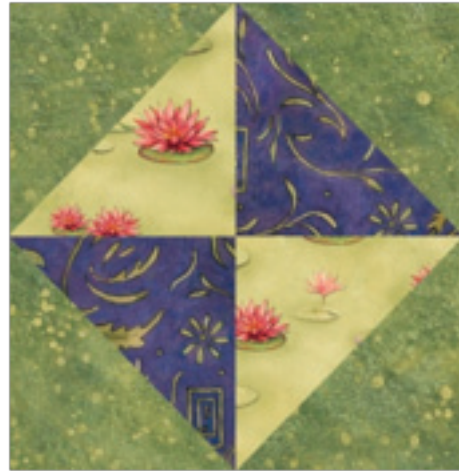


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4. Referring to the quilt picture, sew four half square triangle squares from Step 1 together to make a block. Repeat to make a total of eight blocks. (Step 4)

5. Sew four Unit 12 Spot On Texture Yellow triangles to each side of a Unit 16 Tulip Bliss 5 1/2" square. Repeat to make two square in a square blocks. (Step 5)



6. Sew four Unit 6 Spot On Texture Green triangles to each side of a Unit 16 Tulip Bliss 5 1/2" square. Repeat to make two square in a square blocks. (Step 6)



7. Referring to the quilt picture, sew a step 6 square in a square block in between two step 4 half square triangle blocks. Repeat to make four rows. (Step 7)
8. Sew two of the rows to the sides of the Step 3 piece. (Step 8)
9. Sew one Unit 15 Tulip Bliss 7 1/2" square to both ends of the two remaining rows. Sew the two rows to the top and bottom of the Step 8 piece. (Step 9)
10. Sew one purple Unit 10 to each side of the Unit 2 and Unit 3 rectangles to make four border strips. Sew two of the strips to the sides of the Step 9 piece. (Step 10)
11. Sew one Unit 4 Spot On Dot Green 4" squares to each end of the remaining two border strips. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the Step 10 piece. (Step 11)
12. Layer, bind and quilt as desired. (Step 12)



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
