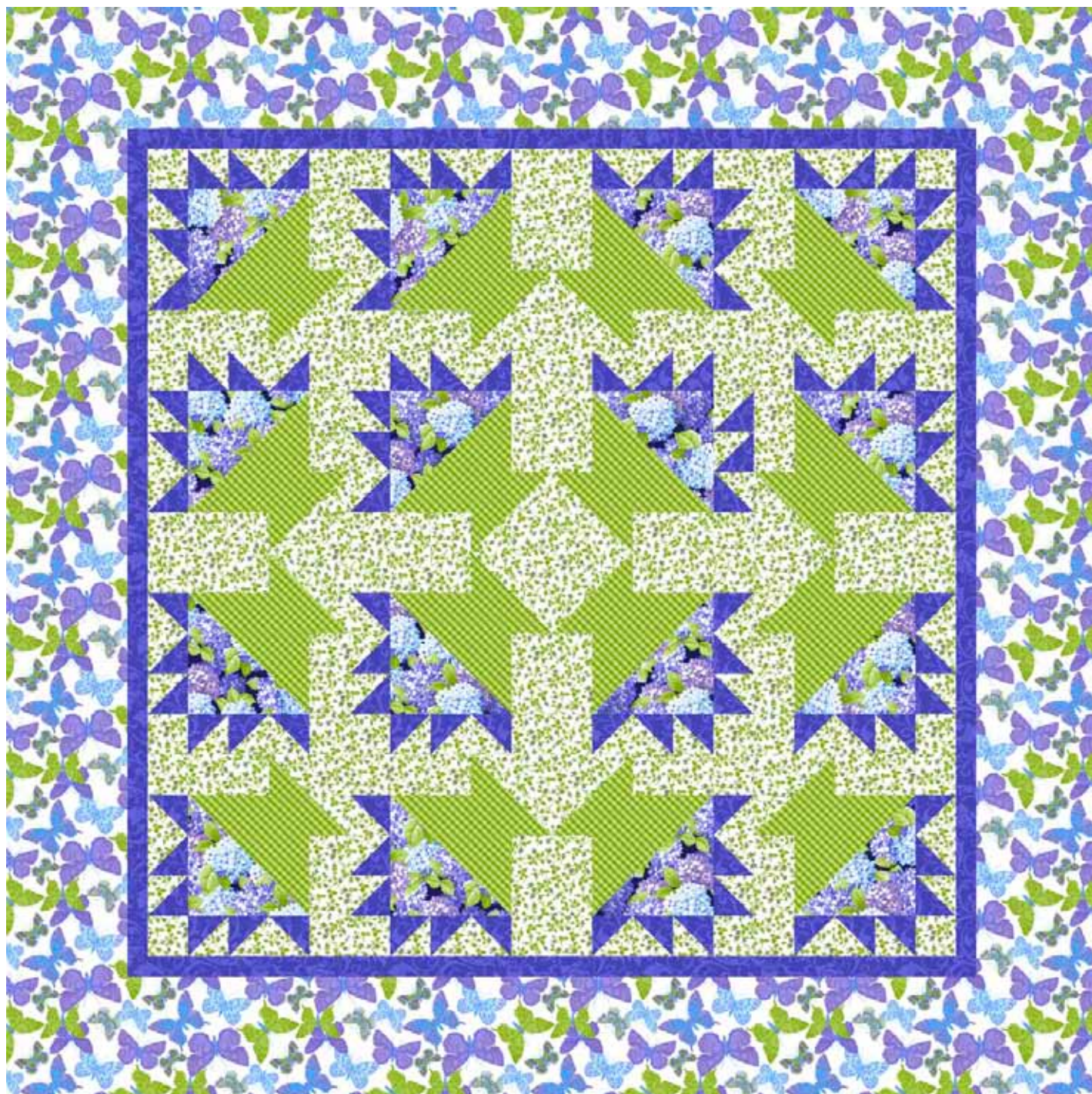

Hydrangea Quilt

SUPPLIES AND TOOLS NEEDED:

½ yard Packed Floral	1 yard Swirl
3 ½ yards Packed Floral (for backing)	Twin-size batting
1 ⅝ yards Spring Rose	Basic sewing supplies
⅝ yard Hydrangea Gingham	Sewing machine
1 yard Butterflies	

DIRECTIONS:

Seam allowances are ¼"
 WOF = width of fabric.
 Label all pieces as you cut.
 Measure the quilt top before cutting border lengths.

CUTTING:

From Packed Floral cut:
 2 strips 6 ⅞" x WOF. From these strips cut 8 - 6 ⅞" squares. Cut these squares in half = 16 half square A triangles. Unit 1

From Spring Rose cut:
 2 strips 2 ½" x WOF. From these strips cut 32 - 2 ½" C squares. Unit 2
 6 strips 2 ½" x WOF. From these strips cut 32 - 2 ½" x 6 ½" D rectangles. Unit 3
 5 strips 2 ⅞" x WOF. From these strips cut 64 - 2 ⅞" squares. Cut these squares in half = 128 half square B triangles. Unit 4

From Hydrangea Gingham cut:
 2 strips 2 ⅞" x WOF. From these strips cut 16 - 2 ⅞" squares. Cut these squares in half = 32 half square B triangles. Unit 5
 2 strips 6 ⅞" x WOF. From these strips cut 8 - 6 ⅞" squares. Cut these squares in half = 16 half square A triangles. Unit 6

From Swirl cut:
 5 strips 1 ½" x WOF = Inner Borders. Unit 7
 6 strips 2 ¼" x WOF = Binding. Unit 8
 4 strips 2 ⅞" x WOF. From these strips cut 48 - 2 ⅞" squares. Cut these squares in half = 96 half square B triangles. Unit 9

From Butterflies cut:
 Cut 5 strips 6 ½" x WOF = Outer Borders. Unit 10

ASSEMBLY:

 Refer to diagrams.

1. Join one Unit 4 Spring Rose B triangle and one Unit 9 Swirl B triangle to make one triangle square. Make six triangle squares for one block. Fig. 1.
2. In the same manner, make a triangle square using one Unit 4 Spring Rose B triangle and one Unit 5 Hydrangea Gingham B triangle. Make two triangle squares for one block.
3. In the same manner, make one large triangle square using one Unit 1 Packed Floral A triangle and one Unit 6 Hydrangea Gingham A triangle. You need one per block. Fig. 3.
4. Referring to the block assembly diagram, lay out six B triangle-squares, two Unit 2 Spring Rose C squares, and two Unit 3 Spring Rose D rectangles as shown. Join into sections; join sections to complete one block. Make 16 blocks. Fig. 4.
5. Lay the blocks out as shown in the quilt photo. Join the blocks into rows. Press the seams in rows 1 and 3 to the left. Press the seams in rows 2 and 4 to the right.

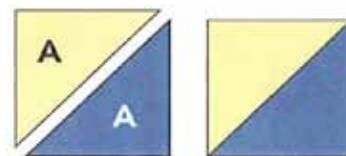


Fig. 2 Triangle Square Diagram

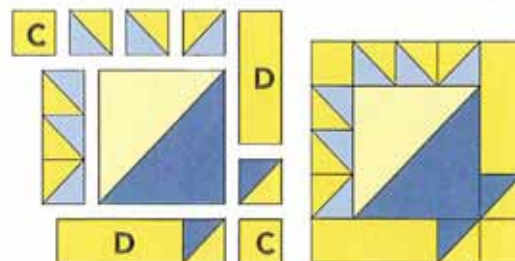


Fig. 3 Block Assembly Diagram & Block Diagram

6. Matching the seams on each row, sew the rows together in two sections as follows: rows 1 and 2, then rows 3 and 4. Join these two sections together. Press the seams in one direction.
7. Border #1 – Sew the Unit 7 - 1 ½" Swirl inner border strips together in a long strip. Measure the sides of the quilt top, average the two measurements and use the average number to cut two border strips. Sew these border strips to the sides of the quilt top. Measure the top and bottom of the quilt top, average the two measurements and use the average number to cut two border strips. Sew these border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
8. Border #2 – Same as Step 7 using the Unit 10 - 6 ½" Butterflies outer border strips.
9. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
