Harvest Scarecrow Wall Hanging

Project skill level: Beginner

Project time: 2 hours

Supplies & tools:

- No Sew Method:
 - 1 yd. fusible fleece
- Low Sew Method:
 - 1 yd. Hi Loft Batting
 - 1 yd. fabric for backing
 - Craft glue or glue gun and glue sticks
 - Wire coat hanger or plastic rings

Directions:

- No Sew Method
 1. Lay wall hanging on fusible fleece and fuse according to manufacturer's instructions.
 2. Cut out wall hanging and embellishments through both layers.
 3. Create a 3-D effect! Layer cut pieces of batting under embellishments and glue to door panel using glue gun or craft glue.
- Low Sew Method:
 1. Cut out all printed pieces leaving a 1/2" seam allowance around each piece.
 2. Use cut pieces as patterns to cut backing fabric and batting.
 3. Layer all fabric pieces, wrong sides together, placing batting in the middle.
 4. Sew through all layers along outer edge of design.
 5. Glue embellishments to wall hanging to create 3-D effect.



To Hang:

1. Position metal hanger on the back of wall hanging with top of hanger at the top center.
2. Hanger may be bent to conform to shape of wall hanging. Stitch or glue hanger to back at neck of hanger and both ends or stitch small plastic rings to back of wall hanging.
