## Felt Flower Pin Project

Read all directions before beginning any project!

### SUPPLIES:

- Package Crafty Cuts Felt – color of your choice
- 1 pack of embroidery thread to match and 1 needle
- 1 jeweled pin or a fancy button
- A piece of scrap cotton fabric
- 1 package of  $\frac{3}{4}$ " bar pins or fastener of your choice
- Rotary cutter or scissors
- Pencil or fabric marker

### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Using sharp scissors or rotary cutter cut the following:
  - Cut out the pattern pieces
  - Place pattern on the fabric and trace with fabric marker
  - Cut out the shapes once you have traced them onto the fabric

### CONSTRUCTION:

1. Thread the needle
2. Cut a piece of scrap cotton fabric  $\frac{1}{2}$ " sq.
3. Use a gathering stitch to sew around edge of circle. (For best results place the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square of cotton fabric on the edge of the felt, start the stitch in the middle of the square and continue stitching to complete the circle to the other end of the square.)
4. Gently pull thread to gather fabric and close center then tie a knot.
5. Center the gathered fabric in the middle of the circle, cut  $\frac{1}{4}$ " slits into the outside edge all the way around.
6. Place the small flower in the middle of the large flower and stitch in place.
7. Place the jeweled pin or fancy button in the center of the small flower and stitch around to secure in place.
8. Center the bar pin on the back and stitch down.
