Fabric Covered Thumbtacks

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Scrap cotton fabric leftover from previous projects
- Sharp scissors
- Pliers
- Heavy duty bonding glue
- Flathead thumbtacks
- Kits to make covered buttons that include the tools

Instructions: (read before starting project)

- Step 1** Use the pliers to bend the button loops off the back of the buttons.
- Step 2** Neatly trim fabric twice the size of the button.
- Step 3** Center fabric, wrong side up and position fabric and button shell over button maker.
- Step 4** Push into button maker.
- Step 5** Tuck the fabric in.
- Step 6** Using plastic pusher, snap back of button into shell.
- Step 7** Using heavy duty glue, glue flat thumbtacks onto the back of button.
