# GROCERY BAG STORAGE TUBE

Approximate crafting time: 30 minutes

Approximate Finished size: 16" x 5"

## SUPPLIES AND TOOLS NEEDED:

This is a great project to utilize any fabric scraps that you might have lying around!

11W x 18L" piece of fabric

Note: you can customize the length of the grocery bag tube by cutting it longer or shorter if desired.

15" of ¼-inch elastic, cut in half

7" of ribbon

Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies.

## DIRECTIONS:

Please read all instructions before beginning.

All seam allowances are 3/8".

## CONSTRUCTION:

1. To form a casing at each 11" end of the tube panel, turn bottom and top raw edges under ¼" and press, then turn under another ½". Press and stitch along fold to form elastic casings.

2. Using a safety pin, thread elastic strips through the top and bottom casings, making sure to pull the elastic ends out ½" on each end of the casing. Pin to hold.

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3. Make a loop with the ribbon and on the right side of fabric, pin it about 1" down from the tube top, making sure that it's at a slight angle and pointing upwards.
4. With right sides together, pin raw edges of tube panel together. Stitch along raw edge, making sure to catch the elastic ends and the ribbon ends in your seam.
5. Turn inside out and enjoy!
