Butterfly Catcher Project

Read all directions before beginning any project!

SUPPLIES:

- ½ yd of tulle
- Strip of fabric 1" wide by 18" long
- Dowel rod
- Wire hanger
- Pliers/Wire Cutter
- Hot glue gun
- Needle & thread
- Ruler
- Pen

PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS:

- Using the pliers/wire cutter, cut off the hook of the hanger where it begins to curve.
- Shape the hanger into a circle (it helps to have 2 sets of hands doing this part).
- Using your hot glue gun, apply glue to the spiral part of the hanger and attach to one end of the dowel rod. Hold there until the glue dries.
- Apply glue to one end of the fabric strip and attach over hanger and dowel rod. Wrap the ribbon around the dowel rod and hanger covering completely, applying hot glue along the way.
- Measure around circle of wire hanger. Cut tulle this length plus 1/2" for seam allowance. Turn under ½" at top of tulle and press, repeat 2 more times.
- Bring two short side of tulle together and stitch using a ¼" seam allowance.
- Gather raw edge of tulle at bottom and tie a knot to close off the hole.
- Pin tulle around wire hanger folding pressed edge over hanger. Hand stitch place using either a baste stitch or whip stitch.
- Cut out flowers, butterflies, etc. to attach to the net and decorate how you please.
- Get outside and enjoy!
